**Membership:** Carin Ellis

### Mini-Grants: Genny Furley

- Committee reviewed and approved 5 out of 6 applications for mini-grants – a total of \$1400
- Award notices, procedures, and forms were sent to the 5 faculty who had grants awarded

### Community Outreach & Advocacy:

- PTSA was invited to join the Chick Fil A Trunk or Treat on 10/26 from 5-7pm at the Nursery Road / Linthicum CFA. Genny Furley and Carin Ellis have donated the candy and will setup and hand out candy for the PTSA. *Other members are welcome to join and hand out candy! We'll be there at 4:30pm.*
- Stephanie, Bethany, and Lisa working hard to highlight busing/traffic issues. Stephanie and Bethany emailed local elected officials and our Board rep. State Senator Pam Beidle and Delegate Mark Chang went up to NCHS during morning drop off and witnessed the situation. Stephanie spoke at the last Board meeting about the high number of buses out at NCHS and which students are affected. Bethany and Lisa asked questions at the County Executive's Community Forum held at Chesapeake Arts Center. Lisa spoke with Ms Dent, our board rep, who suggested a Town Hall.
- *Mr Fowlkes set up a Town Hall to address Mental Health issues along with an opportunity for parents to speak about busing/transportation issues among any other questions they might have. **Town Hall Announcement – PTSA members please share the information about the upcoming Town Hall on 10/18 @ 6:30pm in the NCHS Auditorium.***

### Old Business:

- Standing rules – voted and approved the following standing rules to clarify some PTSA requirements for committee chairs:
  - Financial training required for all committee chairs. This is 1 hour of slide-based training that Lisa can provide
  - All reimbursement requests and forms must be turned in within 30 days of purchase, and no later than June 15<sup>th</sup>. Any exceptions must be approved by the Board before the June 15<sup>th</sup> cutoff
  - No gift cards received or given out can be over \$50 in value
  - All gift cards (received/given) must be accounted for, and the proper paperwork must be completed (who donated the card, amount, type, who it went to)
- Vacancies that we need to fill with PTSA volunteers:
  - Craft & Vendor Fair, After Prom, Fundraising

### New Business:

- Voted to approve a budget item for Athletic Boosters "Just for One Knight Sponsorship", which the Athletic Boosters has given us a %50 discount on. Total is \$225 for two years.
- Added a budget category for Square & PayPal fees to track it better
