Items

1. President Lisa Crittenden opened the meeting by welcoming those in attendance at 7:03 and introducing everyone.
2. Minutes from last October and November's meetings were reviewed and approved.
3. Membership report
 - i. Two new members were added this month.
4. Treasurer's report
 - i. Checking ledger was reviewed. No questions on any of the entries.
5. Banners Report
 - i. \$900 has been brought in so far this year. Most people have been ordering a banner and a yard sign. We will probably not hit our goal of \$2,000 but given the current environment, sales are doing well.

- ii. Paperwork normally filled out for recommendations and other things necessary for college applications will all be online this year.
- iii. Interims go out Friday.
- iv. Stephanie thanked Mr. Fowlkes for sending out the email just to senior parents regarding banners. Many orders were received in response to that email.
- v. Looking to create a town hall to connect to the community- information went out in the bulletin but was not well received. Will look for other ways to communicate with parents. Parent connect communications seem to work best.
- vi. Approximately 500 students not on parent portal, many are in the ESOL community. Working very hard to connect with those parents.
- vii. Graduation date for this year isn't set yet. Administration is still trying to make alternative plans for graduation if school is not back in person.
- viii. Several parents mentioned how much they enjoyed the virtual experience last year. Mr. Fowlkes agreed that it went well and said that even when we return to in person graduations, the ceremony still be broadcast virtually so that people from out of town can still attend.
- ix. Mr. Fowlkes mentioned an incident that occurred more than a year ago that has been circulating again on Tik Tok regarding a student at North County. He said the school has recently received numerous calls about it. It is a police matter not a school matter.
