Items

- Lisa Crittenden opened the meeting by welcoming those in attendance at 7:06.
- Minutes from last meeting were reviewed and approved.
- Membership report
 - We have 58 adult members and 8 student members.
- Treasurer's report
 - Report reviewed. No questions on any of the entries.
- Banners Report
 - \$2,303.24 was made this year in banner/yard sign sales. \$303.24 over the goal of \$2,000.
 - There are still 17 yard signs and 11 banners left to be picked up. Stephanie is going to set a deadline for pickup.
 - Next year the order form and the information on the website will be in Spanish as well.

- Items to follow up on with Mr. Fowlkes
 - Water bottle refill stations were on the schedule to be installed prior to covid-Upstairs and downstairs in A Hall. Were they installed and can students use them?
 - Prom place is booked pending official approval.
 - Graduation is scheduled for 6/9 @ 6pm. Teachers have been told to order caps and gowns. Still pending official approval and guidelines.
 - There are students sitting the cafeteria during virtual learning. Parents feel this is not what they signed up for. Their students can do that at home. Those students do have the option to return to virtual. There is a limited option to change teachers for students most in need of in person teaching.
 - Multiple classes are in large areas. Students feel they can't talk because it is so quiet and they are trying to be respectful of other students trying to learn. Is this due to lack of monitors?
 - How many more kids will be in the large spaces when the 10th and 11th graders return next week?
 - If students have a class in the cafeteria, is it an option to go home for that class or come in late after doing that class virtually?

- Cost last year was approximately \$140. Still waiting for the final estimate from this year. Pay for it with left over proceeds from banner sales?
- Scholarships:
 - We have 6 applicants so far. The deadline to submit applications is 4/9/21. A reminder will be sent out in the next newsletter. Next year this information will go out in Spanish as well as English.
 - Kim is still waiting to hear back from Guidance with confirmation of awards banquet.
 - Senior awards on 5/20. No word on whether it will be in person or virtual.
- New Business
 - PTSA asked to provide snacks and waters for Volunteers
 - Approved paying for this out of special projects budget.
 - TAAC-work to rule. Teachers will do what is required nothing more.
 - No fundraisers can be picked up at the school.
 - AACC PTA has 2 \$1,000 scholarships that students can apply for. Applications are due 3/26/21.
 - Athletic Boosters thank PTSA for sending a letter to Pam Beidle to continue funding remodeling of the field house. Funding was approved and NCHS will get a new turf field as well. All banners will be up in the stadium next week.
 - Graduation bears are being sold for \$15.
 - Fall sports season starts next week. Spring tryouts start 4/9. The season will last 6-8 weeks.
 - Website needs to be updated.
 - If prom is able to be held, can PTSA contribute somehow, photo booth, donuts, breakfast, favors?
