Items

1. President Lisa Crittenden opened the meeting by welcoming those in attendance at 7:05 and introducing everyone.
2. Minutes from last meeting were only sent to the board, will be sent to everyone and reviewed and approved next meeting along with minutes from this meeting.
3. Membership report
 - i. 57 total memberships, 7 students and 50 adults
4. Treasurer's report
 - i. Treasurer's report reviewed, not much changed from last month.
 - ii. Lisa has money from banner sales in paypal to transfer.
 - iii. Voted to add \$20 to administrative fund from special projects fund to pay for binder and office supplies.
5. Banners Report

- i. Banners are slow this year. One had a mistake on it. The person who ordered it made the mistake. The order was corrected but it made us realize that the person ordering did not get a copy of what was ordered. Form has been changed so that the person who orders gets a copy of exactly what was ordered so they can review it right away. 43 orders total placed in the first round of orders. Some orders were for both a banner and a yard sign, some were just one or the other.
 - ii. Next deadline is 11/30 to order. Pick up for last set of banners went very smoothly. Pickup will be done the same way this time.
 - iii. Question was asked if school does open, will the banners be collected and hung at school. Stephanie would be willing to do it, but we will revisit this if and when school opens up again.
 - iv. Another banner email will be sent out, as well as another Facebook post, ahead of the 11/30 deadline.
6. Principal's Report
- i. Mr. Fowlkes was unable to make it to the meeting tonight.
 - ii. There was a question about Parent Connect and how long it has been down. It is causing the students some anxiety to not be able to access their grades at the end of the semester. This will be relayed to Mr. Fowlkes.

- iv. Amazon Smile brought in \$54.54. Simone suggested pushing Amazon smile to family and friends since many people are doing online shopping right now for the holidays. If there are needs for the school, those could be added to the charity list and bought through Amazon Smile.
