Items

1. President Lisa Crittenden opened the meeting by welcoming those in attendance at 7:04 and introducing everyone.
2. Minutes from last meeting were reviewed and approved
3. Membership report
 - i. 45 adults and 7 students (52 total)
4. Treasurer's report
 - i. Transferred \$1360 from Bank to prom breakfast fund as voted upon last meeting.
 - ii. \$100 paid to AACC PTA (local council) and \$208.25 paid to MD PTA for this years dues.
5. Mr. Fowlkes Report
 - i. Spoke with Mr. Lasher about hosting virtual homecoming but there is concern as to liability for school and PTA in hosting that. Possibility of recording it and posting it to youtube instead of hosting live?

- ii. Some things are being done for spirit week.
 - iii. Teachers have received their gift cards and really appreciated them. Most were mailed but those who work in the building every day received them in person.
 - iv. Plan is still for all teachers to return 11/2 unless they have an accommodation. Still no idea when high school students will return, possibly end of December or January depending on how it goes for younger students. Covid numbers are currently going up.
 - v. SAT day went very well. Plenty of sanitization stations. No problems.
6. Old Business:
- i. Banners/Signs 1st deadline update
 - 1. Stephanie has not heard back from the company yet. We are using a new company this year. 39 people have ordered banners or yard signs so far. Still working out the arrangements for delivery, possibly out of Stephanie's garage.
 - ii. Teachers gift cards purchased and delivered
 - i. \$5 Chick-fil-a gift cards for 230 teachers. Will be either mailed to teachers or given in person on 11/2 when teachers return to school.
 - iii. Snacks/water for volunteers for SAT administration were purchased and delivered.
7. Food Nights

 - iv. Mod Pizza and IHOP nights are being planned but no dates as of yet.
 - 1. Mod Pizza has quite a few nights open in November. Trying to plan so it doesn't conflict with other boosters planned nights. November 30 and January 14 are tentative dates.
 - 2. IHOP-need to confirm that they do takeout as well as dine it.
 - 3. Look to spread the dine out night locations around, maybe include Pasadena and Hanover locations as well as Glen Burnie.

4. Maybe create a master calendar that all the groups use to avoid scheduling dine out nights on the same night or the same restaurant.
 5. Andrea is going to approach A1 pizza about doing a dine out night.
 6. Glory Days does a month-long fundraiser where you collect the receipts and turn them in. Maybe receipts could be scanned in and emailed to be turned in.
 7. GroupRaise is a great site that makes it easy to set up fundraisers.
 8. Mod Pizza gives us 20%. The manager in Glen Burnie gives us 20% of the sales for the whole day not just those who mention being there for the fundraiser.
